Coach Response Notes:

If he responds, send a thank you email and start asking more questions: (Next Bench can help you with email info). Keep connecting with the coach and build a relationship, asking about tryouts, camps, and ways to visit college or how you can come meet coach in person.

If the coach doesn't respond within 2 weeks, send one more follow up email, and if the coach still doesn't respond, make a note, and move on add a new college to your list.
